SUMMARY & RECOMMENDATION

At its March 11 meeting, the City Council approved the appointments of election staff for the May 4, 2024, City of La Porte and LPISD election cycle, including any runoff elections. However, the Alternate Judge for the City Hall polling location was unable to serve and the Judge and Alternate Judge of the Early Voting Ballot Board have conflicting obligations for the main meeting of the Board on election day.

The City Secretary's Office has confirmed that the following individuals are willing to serve in these roles for the June 15, 2024, District 4 Special Election Runoff Election and request that they be appointed:

Joyce Hollan – Alternate Judge, City Hall polling location
Isabel Jackson – Judge, Early Voting Ballot Board
Phillip Hoot – Alternate Judge, Early Voting Ballot Board

Barry Beasley continues to serve as the City Hall polling place election day Judge and the current Early Voting Ballot Board Judge and Alternate Judge were able to serve for the Board's first meeting on June 4. Joyce Hollan, Isabel Jackson, and Phillip Hoot have served as election workers and on the Early Voting Ballot Board previously and the City Secretary's Office sincerely recommends each of them.
